## The products of SWG4.4

- The mobilityDCAT-AP specification
- A set of Controlled Vocabularies

- Each has an own, independent GitHub repository
  - Seperate updates
  - Freedom to use different versions



#### Tools and Processes

- Issue handling
  - During the project lifetime of NAPCORE, SWG4.4 will take care of issues
  - Follow up after NAPCORE is to be concretised
- Issue submission:
  - On the mobilityDCAT-AP GitHub repository
  - Including issues on the Controlled Vocabulary



#### **Tools and Processes**

- Some examples of issues :
  - Problems or remarks about mobilityDCAT-AP releases
  - Changes or new functionalities for future releases
  - Changes in the data model
  - Changes in the Controlled Vocabularies



#### Tools and Processes

- Issues are discussed at the regular SWG4.4 meetings
- Submitters outside the SWG will be invited for the meeting
- The submitter or a SWG member can propose a solution for the issue
- Decisions will be made by consensus of the attendees of the meeting
- Decisions are documented on GitHub



#### Consensus on issues

#### • Minor issues:

- Solution will be proposed in advance of a SWG meeting and presented during the meeting.
- Solution will be accepted if after two weeks of the meeting there is no opposition

### • Major issues:

- Voting during the SWG meeting
- Normally, two-thirds majority of the attendees is needed for acceptance



## Release cycle

#### Bugfixes

- Corrections of errors or consistencies in the specification
- No affection of the operability
- Every six months released in April and October



## Release cycle

- Minor semantic changes
  - May affect the interoperability only in a non-disruptive way
  - Addition of optional properties or 'deprecation' of unused, optional properties
  - Published every ach year published in October



## Release Cycle

- Major semantic changes
  - (More) serious consequences for interoperability
  - For example, the addition of mandatory properties or the mandatory controlled vocabulary
  - Published every two years in October
